Edmund Thomas Clint's life was cut short to just 2522 days due to his prolonged illness from kidney malfunction since the age of two. However, illness couldn't stop the creativity of this child prodigy who made 25,000 pictures within that brief span of time!

Edmund Thomas Clint

Edmund Thomas Clint was the only son of Mr. M.T. Joseph and Chinnamma Joseph from Kochi, Kerala. His life was as short as 2522 days due to a prolonged illness that affected his kidney. But he showed exceptional skills in drawing and painting from a very young age.

Clint used every medium: chalk, crayons, oil paints, and water colours to create drawings and paintings that depicted the world as he saw it. His collection stunned art admirers and critics who were astounded by his maturity and convinced of his artistic genius.

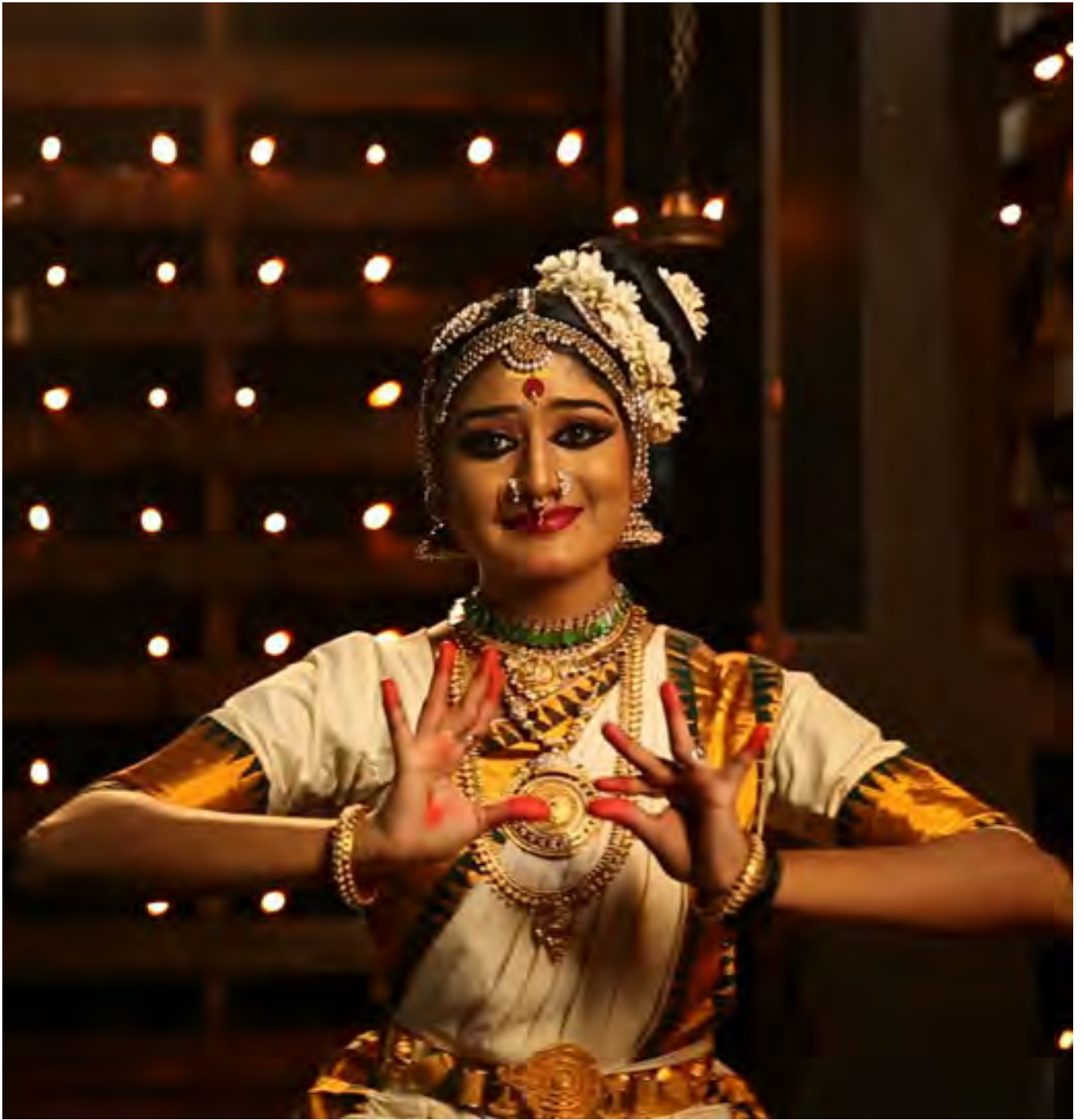

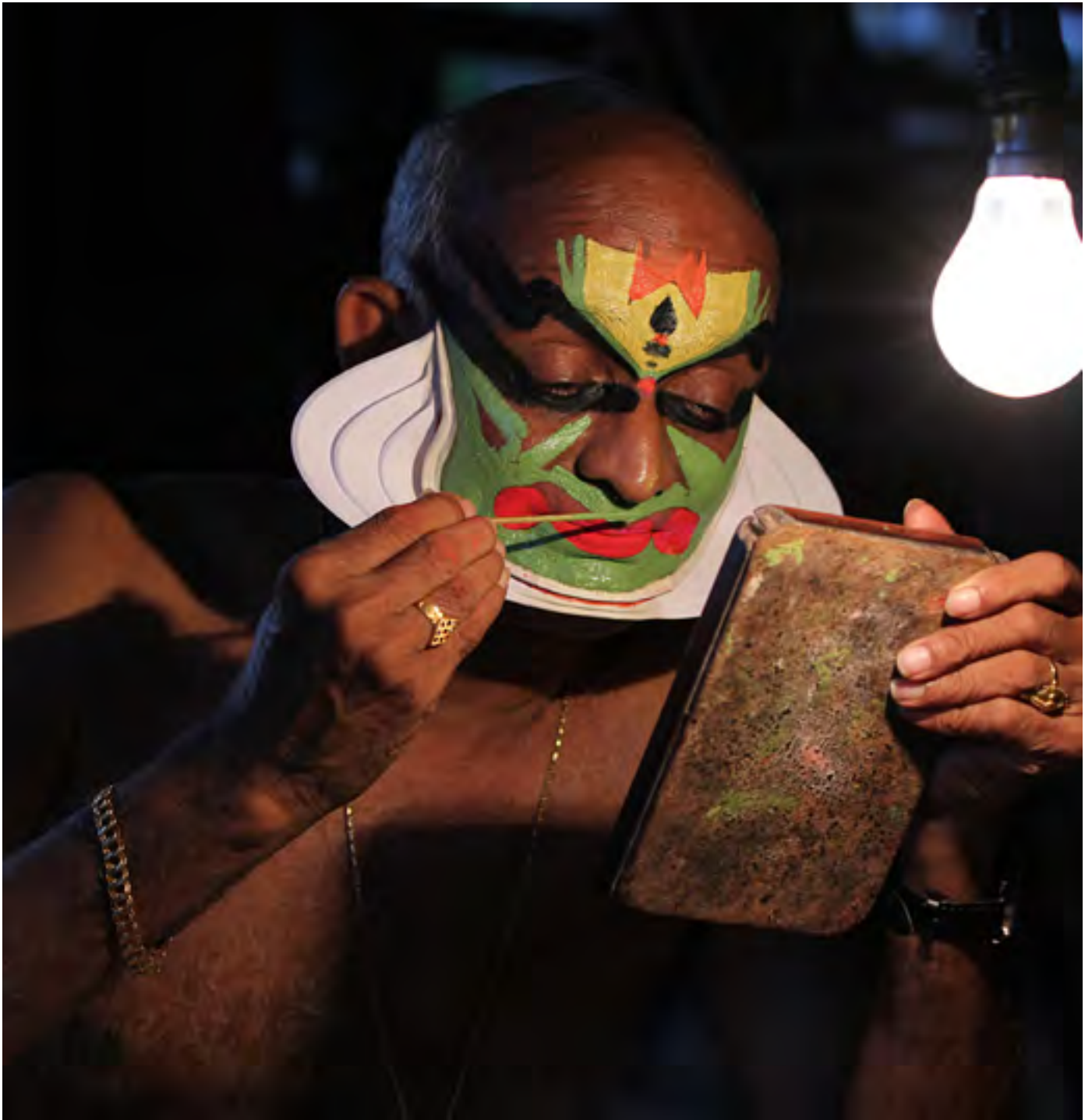

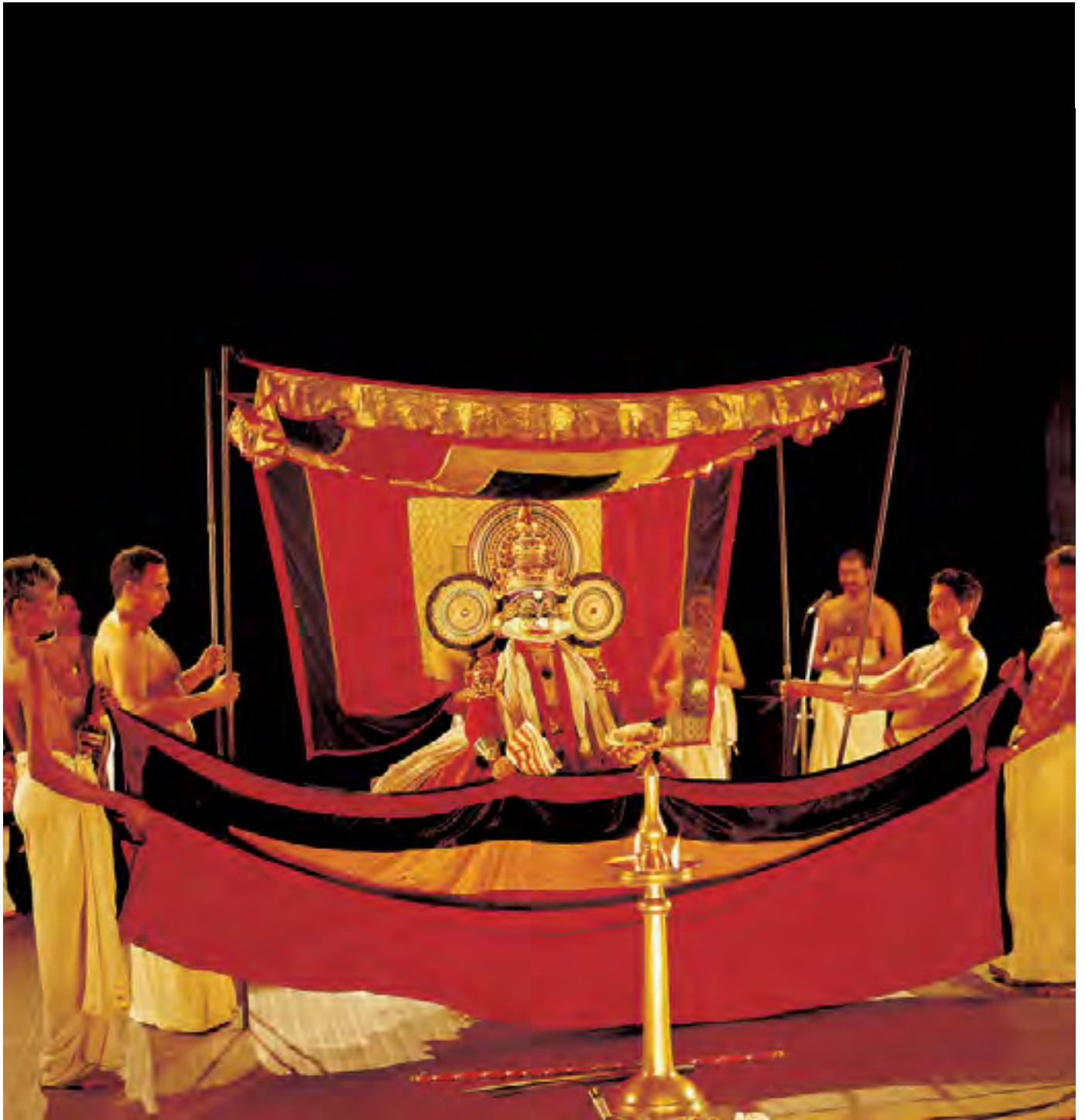
