ABOUT THE FESTIVAL (Legend/History/Myth)

Thangal Uppapa Uroos is a festival celebrated by the local people as a mark of respect to Saint Thangal Uppapa who was originally from Kollam. It takes place once every two years and is usually in the month of *Dul Hijj*. Thangal Uppapa is remembered for his peerless services in Kasargod and Mangalore. The Muhyaddin Juma Majid houses the tomb of Saint Thangal Uppappa and is a pilgrimage center that attracts thousands of devotees

DESCRIPTION *(How festival is celebrated)*

The Thangal Uppappa Uroos is a celebrated event at the Muhyaddin Juma Masjid, one of primitive *masjids* in Kasaragod. The mosque houses the tomb of Thangal Uppapa and attracts a large number of believers. The mosque is also considered as a center of religious unity in the locality. The festival is begun by a flag hoisting ceremony. Every day religious discourses are organized under eminent Islamic scholars and food is provided to the needy and devotees.
