DESCRIPTION (How festival is celebrated)

The festival is celebrated over a period of 4 days and starts with flag hoisting ceremony. From the first day onwards events such as *Kappukettu*, *Thalapoli*, *Kumbhakuda Khoshayathra* are held. *Pooram Idi* is an event which draws attraction of the devotees. Percussion music along with procession is also held during the festival.
