ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

(Legend/History/Myth)

Neendoor Subrahmanya Swamy Temple celebrates the Arattu festival very grandly with thousands of devotees gathering at temple on this special occasion. This festival takes place in between April and May. This is celebrated as a great fair for a week near the temple premises. Neendoor Subrahmanya Swami Temple is a Murugan temple located in Neendoor. Myths have it that the Pandavas and the sage Vyasa had worshipped at this temple. The deity is said to be in an angry and furious mood as he had just killed Tharakasuran. The Vel is pointed downwards. Murugan is worshipped here in the form of Devasenapathi, the supreme general of the holy forces.
