# ABOUT THE FESTIVAL (Legend/History/Myth)

The Pooramahotsavam at the Parakkat Devi Temple is celebrated to commemmorate the legendary victory of *Bhagavathy*, the presiding deity of the temple over the evil *Parasuran*. The grand celebrations last seven days and is considered an occasion to expressing gratitude to the Goddess. The festival is celebrated jointly by the people of Vavulliapuram, Kazhani and Kavassery *Desams*. The preparations for the festival start as early as on the 21<sup>st</sup> of the Malayalam month of *Kumbham* with the unique *Tholpavakoothu*, a traditional form of puppetry.

# **DESCRIPTION** (How festival is celebrated)

The *Pooram*, which is a ritualistic offering to the Goddess consists of brilliant fireworks and takes place on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the Malayalam month of *Meenam*. The celebrations on the day are preceded by various ritualistic and traditional events spread over seven days. People from the three localities of Vavulliapuram, Kazhani and Kavassery actively organize and participate in the festival. The temple is traditionally decorated on the eve and is spectacularly illuminated with a hundred thousand lamps on 19<sup>th</sup> of *Meenam*.
