ABOUT THE FESTIVAL (Legend/History/Myth)

This is one of the most important Shiva temples in Kerala. Lord Shiva here is swayambhoo facing west. It is believed that Lord Shiva after killing Yama in order to save Markandeya, self manifested in this place. Since it is a major Shiva temple, shivarathri festival is celebrated with a great pomp. It is celebrated in gratitude of Lord Shiva who saved the whole world by drinking deathly poison *kalakooda visham*.
