### **ABOUT THE FESTIVAL** (Legend/History/Myth)

In the earlier days the Christian believers of Kallooppara had to depend on the 'Niranam Church' for the holy mass, funeral ceremonies and other religious rites. The journey on Vallom (small boat) through the Manimala and Pampa rivers was tedious, tiresome and risky. The renowned Edapally King happened to see a few number of people coming on a vallom (small boat) singing melodious hymns accompanied by prayers. The king immediately came down to the river bank to observe the sight more closely and found it to be a burial procession, with the body on the floating hearse covered with a white cloth. The procession that started from Manimala was going to Niranam Church for the funeral of the dead, as in those days Niranam Church was the only Christian church in central Travancore. This event moved the King's heart and having realized the hardship of the Christian subjects, he virtually pointed a plot on the other side of the river, and gave sanction to bury the body and built a church there. But there is no clear evidence for the origin and age of the church. It is commonly believed that the founding stone of the church was laid in Malayalam month of Karkadakam 3rd of 515 (A.D.1339). The stone day of the church is being celebrated during the festival.
