ABOUT THE FESTIVAL (Legend/History/Myth)

The Kaliyatta Mahotsavam at the Kanathur Sree Nalvar Daivasthanam is a prominent Theyyam festival. It primarily celebrates the Mother Goddess. Animals, serpents and trees also figure in the ritualistic worship as promising entities. There are different forms of Theyyam, each invariably representing superhuman powers that include heroic characters and ancestral spirits. A variety of Theyyams like Elayor Theyyam, Chamunda Theyyam, Panchoorla Theyyam and Muthor Theyyam are presented in Kanathur.

Each dance form denotes a deity who is worshipped through the dance performance. The ritualistic worship is also accompanied by treating the individual dance performers as deities.
