## DESCRIPTION (How festival is celebrated)

The festival starts with *Kodiyettu* ceremony and is ended with *Arattu* Procession. *Ulsavabali*, *Purappadu*, *Deeparadhana*, *Deepakkazhcha* are the main ritual ceremonies on festival days. All days many arts forms are performed on stage. Dance programs, *Chakyarkoothu*, Classical Music, *Sopana Sangeethom*, *Kadhakali*, *Kurathiyattom* are the main stage shows. The 10th day the festival ended with *Arattu* ceremony with a colourful procession.
