## DESCRIPTION (How festival is celebrated)

The Perumpadappu Puthen Palli Nercha is a Muslim festival that has been attracting a large number of devotees. It is celebrated to commemorate the deeds of the famous Marhoom Kunji Mohammed Musaliar. Special prayers and religious discourses are organized over the festival days. Social and cultural issues are discussed in the premises of the mosque. *Andu nercha* is the famous ceremony in the mosque. *Neichor* (ghee rice) is distributed to devotees and the poor.
